

BROWN'S CHICKEN FEEDS FOR BACK YARD AND COMMERCIAL BROILERS, LAYERS, AND DUCKS

-AVAILABLE IN EITHER BULK OR BAGS-

- **BROWN'S CHICK CHARGER** – A 20% protein high-energy chick starter crumble that baby chicks love to eat. Chick Charger Crumbles are small so that the poult can easily grasp and swallow them. They are medicated with .0125% Amprol to fight coccidiosis. Feed Brown's Chick Charger for six (6) weeks to birds raised as layers, and three (3) weeks to birds raised as broilers.
- **BROWN'S PULLET GROWER** – A non-medicated 20% crude protein crumble fortified with high amounts of calcium and phosphorous required for rapidly growing chickens. Birds raised on Brown's Pullet Grower have sound conformation and strong bones that help them withstand the stress of lay. Feed Brown's Pullet Grower from week 6 to week 18 or two weeks before anticipated date of first lay. For special orders of two ton or more, in either bulk or bags, Brown's Pullet Grower can be manufactured as either a mash or pellet, and can be fortified with the various poultry feed additives that Brown's have in stock.
- **BROWN'S HI ENERGY POULTRY GROWER / FINISHER** – A high energy pellet that is ideal to take broilers or capons to market weights. This non-medicated 18% crude protein feed contains 6% added fat and elevated levels of all the B vitamins and trace minerals that rapidly growing poultry need to effectively convert feed into meat. High levels of vitamin D, calcium, magnesium, and manganese help prevent leg problems commonly encountered in raising meat birds to heavy weights. Brown's blend of essential amino acids insures that birds on this feed grow efficiently.
- **BROWN'S EGG CHARGER** - This feed may be ordered as either pellets or crumbles. It contains the high amounts of calcium that heavily laying birds need to produce good shell quality. The energy level and amino acid balance is ideal to meet the demands of heavy lay. Brown's continue to add alfalfa meal to Egg Charger to insure a beautiful yellow yolk and to stimulate feed intake. This is a commercial layer feed available for back yard poultry enthusiasts. Brown's Egg Charger is one of our most popular feeds. It is manufactured weekly and is fresh when your chickens get it. Because of its freshness and flavor, your chickens will love to eat Brown's Egg Charger.
- **BROWN'S GAME BIRD BREEDER NT** – This is an 18% layer feed designed specifically for game bird breeders, but can also be used on any poultry species such as bantam chickens and guinea fowl, which require a higher amount of protein in their feeds. Brown's Game Bird Breeder NT is available as a short cut pellet, but can be special ordered in any form for orders of two-ton or more. Since Game Bird Breeder is medicated with Neo-Terramycin it should be withdrawn two weeks before birds are slaughtered. During this time the non-medicated Brown's Egg Charger can be fed. Eggs may be consumed from chickens fed Neo-Terramycin.
- **BROWN'S 36 POULTRY CONCENTRATE** – This feed is a 36% Poultry Concentrate formulated to meet all nutritional needs of growing poultry. Use between 550 lbs. and 1000 lbs. of 36 Layer Concentrate per ton along with corn, barley, oats, wheat, and scratch feeds to mix a feed just right for your poultry. A layer feed may be formulated using Brown's 36% Poultry Concentrate if an additional source of calcium such as limestone or oyster shells is added to the mix at 60 to 100 lbs. per ton. Consult with Brown's Nutritionists or Area Directors if you need assistance in determining the specific amount of concentrate that is correct for your specific needs.
- **BROWN'S DUCK GROWER PELLETS** – This 18% duck pellet is designed to meet the needs of rapidly growing ducks. Under good management, it is not uncommon for ducks to reach weights of

6 lbs. in 7 to 8 weeks when fed Brown's Duck Grower Pellets. Ducks need to have access to large amounts of water, and have feed available at all times to obtain this desired rate of growth. Brown's Duck Pellets may be used to feed domestic or wild ducks and geese, but Brown's Game Bird Breeder should be used during the laying period to insure adequate hatchability of their eggs.

- **BROWN'S SCRATCH GRAINS** - This feed is a blend of cracked corn, wheat, barley, and oats that may be used as a supplemental feed for birds consuming large amounts of protein from other sources such as insects and grasses. It may also be used to fatten poultry after they reach mature size, or can be fed in conjunction with Brown's 36 Poultry Supplement or 22 Layer Pellets. This feed should not be used as a growing feed for young birds or for wild birds since it is not adequately fortified with the vitamins, amino acids and minerals rapidly growing birds need.

- **BROWN'S 22 LAYER** – A 22% layer pellet designed to be fed along with scratch grains or other home raised grains to meet the needs of heavy lay. This feed is an excellent feed for range fed birds and is balanced to the same exacting standards as Brown's Egg Charger.
- **BROWN'S DEVELOPER 1 AND DEVELOPER 2** – These feeds are designed to take pullets through grow-out. Developer 1 is fed during weeks 6 to 12, and Developer 2 from weeks 12 to 20 weeks. Various medications are available to meet specific problems on your farm.
- **BROWN'S CHICK CHARGER CONCENTRATE** – A 40% chicken starter concentrate designed to be mixed with your corn at rates of 800 to 500 lbs. per ton to raise chickens from day 1 into lay. Chick Charger Concentrate can be manufactured with Amprol to fight coccidiosis or various other medications to meet your specific needs.
- **BROWN'S 13% POULTRY MAINTENANCE PELLETS** – A 13% Poultry Maintenance Pellet designed for mature birds at full feed to provide nutritionally important amounts of amino acids, protein, energy, vitamins, and minerals. These pellets are carefully designed to provide optimum fiber, while at the same time preventing birds from overeating. This feed may be used as a molting feed after molt has started, or may be used as a holding feed to carry breeders through the winter months till they are ready to lay again in the spring. During extremely cold winter weather conditions Brown's 13% Poultry Maintenance Pellets can be manufactured with 1 or 2% additional fat or soy oil to help supplement the flocks need for additional energy to provide heat.
- **BROWN'S 18 AND 21% TURKEY GROWER WORMER PELLETS** - These relatively new medicated feeds contain Safeguard (Fenbendazole) and work well at protecting poultry under range conditions. Safeguard is an excellent wormer that removes & controls most stomach and intestinal worms and will have some effect on gapeworm. Producers who house poultry on range find this will also help at preventing Blackhead by removing the intermediate host from the range area.
- **BROWN'S ALL-NATURAL LINE OF POULTRY FEEDS** – Formulas are available to manufacture a full line of "All Natural" poultry and turkey feeds. These feeds are manufactured without antibiotics, meat meal, feather meal, or animal fat. The base ingredients for these feeds are corn, wheat midds from flour manufacturing, barley, and roasted soybeans. Additional soybean meal, distillers grains, and corn oil can be used to provide additional amino acids and energy.
